The “Fondation pour la Recherche en Hématologie Peter Anton et Anna Katharina Miescher” and the Swiss Society of Hematology (SSH) **are inviting bids for 2020-2021 for a subsidy of CHF 100,000 for a 2-year research project** in clinical or basic research in haematology, including transfusion medicine.

The project must be submitted by midnight on 30.11.2019 (Swiss time) by e-mail to the address of the SSH (info@sgh-ssh.ch). The candidate must be either a haematologist, in training to become a haematologist or a biologist who is active in a private or public haematological research group based in Switzerland. An exception may be made for a project author who is working abroad as long as the research project is supported by a Swiss institution which has a connection to this individual. The author must be a Swiss national working in Switzerland or abroad, or a foreign national, where, in the latter case, the research project must be implemented in Switzerland.

A brief description must be submitted to present the status of the research project in question. The main part must describe the objectives of the project, the material and methods being used to implement the project and give information on other existing funding apart from the possible support that may be forthcoming from the Foundation and the SSH.

A summary must be provided which includes the importance of the proposed research project and the most significant bibliographical references. This document must be no longer than 5 pages of A4, written in font size 12 and with single line spacing.

The last document must describe the financial plan for the research project, including evidence of how the money will be used and a short curriculum vitae of the researcher on no more than 4 pages of A4, will complete the dossier of the candidate. The project description, but not the other documents, must be drafted in English.
