Requirements for your application:

- You are a hematologist or a hematologist undergoing further training in hematology or a biologist actively involved in a public or private hematological research group based in Switzerland.
- In exceptional cases, you work abroad, in which case the research project must be supported by a Swiss institution that has a connection with you.
- In case you are a hematologist of foreign citizenship, your research must be conducted in Switzerland.

Your project description should include:

- Introduction: a brief description of the status of the research project in question
- Main part: Description of the methods used to realise the project, description of the objective(s) of your research.
- Information on other available funds, apart from possible support from the Foundation and the SSH
- Abstract: emphasises the importance of the proposed research project and includes the main bibliographical references

This document must not exceed 5 A4 pages in total, (font size 12, single line spacing), and must be written in English.

Please also submit the following documents:

- Financial plan describing the research project, including how the money will be used
- Curriculum Vitae (maximum 4 A4 pages)

The prize winner will be officially announced by the SSH and the Foundation at the Swiss Oncology and Hematology Congress (SOHC) in November 2024.
