*The Fondation pour la Recherche en Hématologie Peter Anton et Anna Katharina Miescher and the Swiss Society of Hematology (SSH) are awarding a grant of **CHF 100'000** for a two-year research project in the field of **clinical or experimental hematology**, including **transfusion medicine**, for the years **2026-2027**.*

Participation requirements

- You are a specialist hematology, are in postgraduate education in hematology or are an active biologist in a public or private hematology research group based in Switzerland.
- In exceptional cases, researchers working abroad can also participate - provided that the project is supported by a Swiss institution associated with you.
- If you are not a Swiss citizen, the project must be carried out in Switzerland.

1. First round of applications:

Please send a **short project description** (max. 1 page, in English) and your **CV** by **31 October 2025 (midnight, Swiss time)** at the latest: info@sgh-ssh.ch

2. Shortlist:

The jury will draw up a **shortlist of a maximum of eight projects** from all applications by **31 January 2026**.

3. Second application round - detailed project documents:

The candidates selected for the shortlist will then be contacted by the office and asked to submit a detailed application dossier by **15 March 2026**.

Requirements for the detailed application dossier (max. 5 A4 pages, font size 11, single line spacing, in English)

- **Introduction:** Brief summary of the current state of research.
- **Main part:** Detailed description of the planned methods and research objectives.
- **Funding:** Information on other existing sources of funding in addition to the requested grant.
- **Summary:** Relevance and scientific significance of the project including important literature references.

To be submitted additionally:

- A **financial plan** showing how the funding is to be used.

The official announcement of the award winner will take place at the Swiss Oncology and Hematology Congress (SOHC) in November 2026.
